

E.C.H.O Terms of Service

Last Updated: 04/01/2026

These Terms of Service ("Terms") govern your access to and use of the E.C.H.O platform, website, and related services (collectively, the "Service") operated by Adam Aerospace Corp ("E.C.H.O/STRIKE," "we," "us," or "our"). By creating an account or accessing or using the Service, you agree to be bound by these Terms. If you are accepting these Terms on behalf of a company or other legal entity, you represent and warrant that you have the authority to bind that entity to these Terms, in which case "you" and "Customer" refer to that entity.

If you do not agree to these Terms, do not access or use the Service.

1. Overview of the Service

The Service is a mobile platform that provides communication tools online and on local area networks.

2. Eligibility

You must be at least 18 years of age to use the Service. By registering for an account, you represent that you meet this requirement. The Service is not directed to individuals under 18.

3. Account Registration and Security

3.1. To access the Service, you must register for an account by providing a valid email address and any other information requested during the registration process. You agree to provide accurate, current, and complete information and to update such information as necessary.

3.2. You are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of your account credentials and for all activity that occurs under your account. You agree to notify Adam Aerospace immediately at jeremy@adamaerocorp.com of any unauthorized use of your account or any other breach of security.

3.3. Accounts are for individual use. Each user must have a separate account. You may not share your account credentials with any other person.

4. Subscription and Payment

4.1. **Fees.** Access to the Service requires a paid subscription. The applicable fees are set forth on the E.C.H.O website or in a separate Order Form executed between you and E.C.H.O. If you and E.C.H.O have executed an Order Form, the terms of the Order Form will control to the extent of any conflict with these Terms.

4.2. **Billing.** Subscription fees are billed monthly in advance via our third-party payment processor (currently Stripe). By subscribing, you authorize E.C.H.O and its payment processor to charge the payment method on file for all applicable fees.

4.3. **Taxes.** All fees are exclusive of taxes. You are responsible for all applicable taxes, excluding taxes based on E.C.H.O net income.

4.4. **Cancellation.** You may cancel your subscription at any time through your account settings or by contacting jeremy@adamaerocorp.com. Cancellation will take effect at the end of your current billing period. No refunds or credits will be issued for partial billing periods.

4.5. **Changes to Fees.** E.C.H.O may change subscription fees upon 30 days' prior written notice (email to your registered address constitutes written notice). Continued use of the Service after the effective date of a fee change constitutes your acceptance of the new fees. If you do not agree to the revised fees, you may cancel your subscription before the change takes effect.

5. License Grant and Restrictions

5.1. **License.** Subject to your compliance with these Terms and payment of all applicable fees, E.C.H.O grants you a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, non-sublicensable, revocable license to access and use the Service during your subscription term solely for your internal business or personal research and analysis purposes.

5.2. **Restrictions.** You will not, and will not permit any third party to:

- (a) copy, modify, adapt, translate, reverse engineer, decompile, or disassemble any portion of the Service or its underlying technology;
- (b) access or use the Service to build a competitive product or service, or to benchmark the Service against a competing product or service;
- (c) use any robot, spider, scraper, or other automated means to access the Service or extract data from the Service, except as expressly permitted by E.C.H.O in writing;
- (d) resell, sublicense, distribute, or otherwise make the Service available to any third party;
- (e) remove, obscure, or alter any proprietary notices, labels, or marks on the Service;
- (f) use the Service in any manner that violates applicable law or regulation; or
- (g) use the Service to transmit any content that is unlawful, harmful, threatening, abusive, defamatory, or otherwise objectionable.

6. User Conduct and Feedback

6.1. **Prohibited Submissions.** You agree not to submit, upload, or transmit through the Service (including through any feedback feature) any material non-public information ("MNPI"), personally identifiable information of third parties, or any other sensitive, confidential, or regulated information. E.C.H.O does not ingest or knowingly process MNPI. You are solely responsible for ensuring that your use of the Service complies with all applicable securities laws, regulations, and internal compliance policies.

6.2. **Feedback.** If you provide E.C.H.O with suggestions, ideas, enhancement requests, recommendations, or other feedback regarding the Service ("Feedback"), you grant E.C.H.O a non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free, irrevocable, perpetual license to use, reproduce, modify, and incorporate such Feedback into the Service and E.C.H.O's other products and services without restriction or obligation to you. This license does not extend to your confidential business information or your proprietary data.

7. Intellectual Property

7.1. **E.C.H.O IP.** E.C.H.O and its licensors retain all right, title, and interest in and to the Service, including all software, algorithms, models, data, content, and all related intellectual property rights. These Terms do not convey to you any ownership interest in or to the Service.

7.2. **Output.** The analytical outputs generated by the Service ("Output") are provided for informational purposes only. E.C.H.O retains all rights in the Service's underlying technology, models, and methodologies used to generate Output. You may use Output solely for your internal research and analysis purposes in accordance with these Terms.

7.3. **Third-Party Data.** The Service incorporates data from third-party sources. Your use of such data is subject to the terms and restrictions imposed by those third-party data providers. You agree not to

redistribute, republish, or commercially exploit third-party data obtained through the Service except as expressly permitted.

8. Data Practices

8.1. Minimal Data Collection. E.C.H.O collects limited information from users, consisting primarily of account information (e.g., email address), payment information processed by our third-party payment processor, and usage data (e.g., feature interactions and session data). E.C.H.O does not collect, ingest, or store your proprietary research, portfolio data, or investment positions.

8.2. Data Use. E.C.H.O may use aggregated and de-identified usage data to improve and develop the Service. Such aggregated data will not identify you or any individual user.

8.3. Privacy. E.C.H.O's collection and use of personal data is governed by the E.C.H.O Privacy Policy available at [Adamaerospace.com](https://adamaerospace.com) which is incorporated into these Terms by reference.

9. Third-Party Services

The Service utilizes third-party service providers, cloud infrastructure providers (e.g., Amazon Web Services), technology development partners, and payment processors (e.g., Stripe). E.C.H.O is responsible for the performance of the Service as a whole. E.C.H.O does not share your personal data with these providers except as necessary to operate the Service and as described in the Privacy Policy.

12. Indemnification

You agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless E.C.H.O and its affiliates, officers, directors, members, managers, employees, and agents from and against any and all claims, losses, liabilities, damages, costs, and expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) arising out of or related to: (a) your use of the Service; (b) your breach of these Terms; (c) your violation of any applicable law or regulation; or (d) any investment or financial decision made by you in connection with information obtained through the Service.

13. Term and Termination

13.1. **Term.** These Terms are effective upon your acceptance and continue for as long as you maintain an active account or subscription.

13.2. **Termination by You.** You may terminate these Terms at any time by canceling your subscription and closing your account.

13.3. **Termination by E.C.H.O.** E.C.H.O may suspend or terminate your access to the Service at any time, with or without cause, upon notice to you. If E.C.H.O terminates your access without cause, E.C.H.O will provide a pro-rata refund of any prepaid fees for the unused portion of your subscription term. If E.C.H.O terminates your access due to your breach of these Terms, no refund will be issued.

13.4. **Effect of Termination.** Upon termination, your right to access and use the Service will cease immediately. Sections 6.2, 7, 10, 11, 12, 14, and 15 will survive termination.

14. Dispute Resolution

14.1. **Governing Law.** These Terms are governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Delaware, without regard to its conflict-of-laws principles.

14.2. **Arbitration.** Any dispute, claim, or controversy arising out of or relating to these Terms or the Service will be resolved by binding arbitration administered by the American Arbitration Association ("AAA") under its then-current Commercial Arbitration Rules. The arbitration will be conducted by a single arbitrator and will take place in Wilmington, Delaware, or at another mutually agreed location. The arbitrator's decision will be final and binding, and judgment on the award may be entered in any court of competent jurisdiction.

14.3. **Exceptions.** Notwithstanding the foregoing, either party may seek injunctive or other equitable relief in any court of competent jurisdiction to prevent the actual or threatened infringement, misappropriation, or violation of intellectual property rights. Claims within the jurisdiction of a small claims court may also be brought in such court.

14.4. **Waiver of Class Actions.** YOU AND E.C.H.O AGREE THAT ANY DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCEEDINGS WILL BE CONDUCTED ONLY ON AN INDIVIDUAL BASIS AND NOT IN A CLASS, CONSOLIDATED, OR REPRESENTATIVE ACTION.

14.5 To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, any claim arising out of or related to these Terms or the Service must be commenced within one (1) year after the cause of action accrues. Any claim not brought within this period is permanently barred.

15. General Provisions

15.1. **Entire Agreement.** These Terms, together with the Privacy Policy and any applicable Order Form, constitute the entire agreement between you and E.C.H.O with respect to the Service and supersede all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, and communications, whether written or oral.

15.2. **Amendments.** E.C.H.O may modify these Terms at any time by posting the revised version on the E.C.H.O website with an updated "Last Updated" date. Material changes will be communicated via email to your registered address at least 10 days before they take effect. Your continued use of the Service after the effective date of any modification constitutes your acceptance of the modified Terms.

15.3. **Assignment.** You may not assign or transfer these Terms or any rights hereunder without E.C.H.O's prior written consent. E.C.H.O may assign these Terms without restriction, including in connection with a merger, acquisition, or sale of all or substantially all of its assets.

15.4. **Severability.** If any provision of these Terms is held to be invalid or unenforceable, that provision will be modified to the minimum extent necessary to make it enforceable, and the remaining provisions will continue in full force and effect.

15.5. **Waiver.** The failure of either party to enforce any right or provision of these Terms will not constitute a waiver of that right or provision.

15.6. **Notices.** E.C.H.O may provide notices to you via email to the address associated with your account. You may provide notices to E.C.H.O at jeremy@adamaerocorp.com

15.7. **Force Majeure.** E.C.H.O will not be liable for any failure or delay in performing its obligations under these Terms due to causes beyond its reasonable control, including natural disasters, acts of government, internet or telecommunications failures, or third-party service provider outages.

15.8. **Independent Contractors.** The relationship between you and E.C.H.O is that of independent contractors. Nothing in these Terms creates a partnership, joint venture, agency, or employment relationship.

This Privacy Policy describes how Adam Aerospace CO., LLC, ("E.C.H.O/STRIKE," "we," "us," or "our") collects, uses, and discloses personal information when you use the E.C.H.O platform, website at www.adamaerospace.com, and related services (collectively, the "Service"). By using the Service, you agree to the practices described in this Privacy Policy.

1. Information We Collect

1.1. Information You Provide

- **Account Information.** When you register for an account, we collect your email address and, if applicable, your name and company name.
- **Payment Information.** When you subscribe to the Service, our third-party payment processor (currently Stripe) collects and processes your payment information (e.g., credit card number, billing address). E.C.H.O does not directly store your full payment card details.
- **Communications.** If you contact us for support or provide feedback through the Service, we collect the content of those communications.

1.2. Information We Collect Automatically

When you use the Service, we automatically collect certain information, including:

- **Usage Data.** Information about your interactions with the Service, such as features accessed, buttons clicked, session duration, and frequency of use.
- **Device and Browser Information.** IP address, browser type, operating system, and device identifiers.
- **Cookies and Similar Technologies.** We use cookies and similar tracking technologies to operate the Service, remember your preferences, and analyze usage patterns. You can manage cookie preferences through your browser settings; however, disabling cookies may affect Service functionality.

The Service is uni-directional: we deliver analytical output to you. We do not receive, process, or have access to your investment data. We do not knowingly process material non-public information (MNPI).

2. How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect for the following purposes:

- To provide, maintain, and operate the Service;
- To process payments and manage your subscription;
- To respond to your inquiries and provide customer support;
- To send you service-related communications (e.g., account notifications, billing confirmations, and security alerts);

- To send you promotional communications about E.C.H.O's products, features, and services. You may opt out of promotional emails at any time by using the unsubscribe link in the email or by contacting us at jeremy@adamaserocorp.com. Opting out of promotional communications does not affect service-related communications;
- To improve and develop the Service, including by analyzing aggregated and de-identified usage data;

 - **AI/LLM Provider:** OpenAI, which processes analytical queries to generate Service output. E.C.H.O stores all prompts and data in its own databases and transmits queries to OpenAI as needed. We do not transmit your personal account information to OpenAI;
 - **Technology Development:** Iron Forge, which provides front-end and back-end development and data warehouse services;
 - **Payment Processing:** Stripe, which processes subscription payments; and
 - Other service providers as necessary to operate the Service.
- **Legal Requirements.** We may disclose your information if required by law, regulation, legal process, or governmental request, or if we believe disclosure is necessary to protect the rights, property, or safety of E.C.H.O, our users, or the public.
- **Business Transfers.** In connection with a merger, acquisition, reorganization, or sale of all or a portion of our assets, your information may be transferred as part of that transaction. We will notify you of any material change in ownership or control that affects the handling of your personal information by updating this Privacy Policy.

We do not sell your personal information. We do not share your personal information with third parties for their direct marketing purposes.

4. Data Retention

We retain your personal information for as long as your account is active or as needed to provide the Service. After you cancel your account, we will retain and use your information as necessary to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our agreements. We will delete or de-identify your personal information when it is no longer needed for these purposes.

5. Data Security
